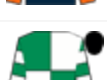

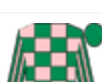
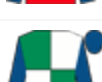
ATR VERDICT: It would be a surprise if COLONEL HARRY were unable to get his head back in front. A winner on his second start over hurdles at Sandown in November, he built on that when returning to the same venue and finishing fourth in the Tolworth earlier this month. The six-year-old wouldn't need to replicate that performance to prove too strong for these rivals. Dare To Shout cost 50,000 pounds at the Cheltenham sale following a point-to-point win in November and is respected, while High Roller's third at Ayr would give him a chance of being in the mix.
