ATR VERDICT: Watamu was getting 7lb from Khrisma when holding on for a narrow win at Huntingdon and she's likely to struggle to confirm that form but, even so, preference is for GETAWHISKY. Dan Skelton's mare fell at Ascot in November, but put that behind her to record a cosy success at Windsor and it's quite possible that she'll find further progress. Chepstow winner Charisma Cat arrives with a fair chance, and don't rule out Edith Pelham, who made a pleasing hurdles debut at Warwick.

The latest saw him denied by the narrowest of margins on Trials Day at Cheltenham and he can boost his confidence before a potential return there next month. Personal Ambition has lost his way, but the application of blinkers could help him recapture the form that saw him claim Grade 2 glory as a novice hurdler. Old Cowboy struck over C&D before a Kempton fall, but concedes weight to higher-rated opponents.

The six-year-old hit the woodwork over C&D on Boxing Day but did pull well clear with the winner, meaning a 4lb rise could be lenient. Alice Stevens got a tune out of Worth The Walk last time and she won't be far away if reproducing those levels.

ATR VERDICT: TALAKAN has taken well to jumping and built on his Ascot third when touched off at Ludlow. The Toby Lawes-trained juvenile receives weight all round and can continue his forward momentum. Lancelot Allen has been off since beating just one home in the Champion Bumper, but his Bangor defeat of a now 118-rated hurdler makes him of interest on his return. Galashiels and Fouroneohfever are decent Flat recruits who are getting the hang of hurdling, while Giantsgrave is much better than he showed at Ffos Las.

ATR VERDICT: Although the strength of the form is up for debate, MADAME LUNA is now three out of three and that should not be underestimated. The daughter of Sea The Moon steps into handicaps from a mark of 110, which looks fair, and her jumping is a real asset. Railway Bell went clear up the run-in at Ludlow so is likely to do even better upped in trip. The hat-trick seeking Snowrocco might still be ahead of the handicapper, despite a further 9lb hike.
