ATR VERDICT: SPENDMORE LANE has been improved by the application of an eye-shield, going under by less than a length over 5f here before a solid Lingfield fourth. In a race that won't take much winning, David Loughnane's filly gets the vote ahead of Woodhay Whisper, who had Punchbowl Flyer well in arrears when making the frame over C&D. White Umbrella is worth a look on her return, while Water Of Leith is an obvious contender if turned out quickly following Monday night's engagement here.



ATR VERDICT: Tony Carroll hasn't taken long to work GALAXY WONDER out and after sharing the spoils here on Boxing Day, the four-year-old has twice performed with credit as the 2/1 favourite. Returning to Dunstall Park is in his favour and the handicapper may have been hasty in dropping him 1lb.
