ATR VERDICT: HURRICANE PAT ran away with a Listed contest at Sandown before getting closest to top novice Old Park Star in the Rossington Main. Possibly in an attempt to avoid his Haydock conqueror, he was upped in trip at the Cheltenham Festival and acquitted himself well in the Turners before the petrol gauge hit empty. This is a good opportunity for a nice little confidence boost and he remains a smart prospect. Winning pointer Cosmic Connection made a successful hurdling debut at Warwick and looks the one for the forecast, with Both Of Us a place chance.

ATR VERDICT: TOUQUET found one too strong when attempting to add to a Huntingdon brace at Wincanton but there was no disgrace in finishing second, especially with the winner following up at Ascot last weekend. The Nick Gifford-trained seven-year-old still has plenty more to offer over fences and is preferred to Supreme George, who has done nothing wrong since completing a Catterick double but might just be in the handicapper's grip. Diligent Militia is unlikely to live up to his lofty price tag, although he might do better now chasing and handicapping.
