ATR VERDICT: Mighty Vega had Roccobear (second) and Okiru (fifth) in behind him over C&D two starts ago before appearing unsuited by a drop in trip last time. He was 6lb out of the handicap that day too and should fare better this time around, but a chance can be taken on VICTORY ACE. The Zoustar gelding showed a bit of promise in two starts for Roger Varian and can be forgiven a low-key stable bow for the John Butler team now pitched into handicaps for the first time.
