ATR VERDICT: Ger Lyons has won three of the last eight renewals and HOWD'YADOIT is likely to prove competitive. The three-year-old will be sharper for a recent comeback and had enough speed to win over the minimum trip at Down Royal last term before landing a valuable sales race at Naas in August. Eclairage ended last season with a creditable fourth in Group 3 company at Dundalk. She could shape well on her reappearance, while Lethimfly is not badly treated on his best form.

ATR VERDICT: SHABAB AL AHLI was only beaten a length into fourth in a traditionally strong Newbury affair and this year's contest already looks up to scratch, with the winner going on to land the Lingfield Derby Trial and the runner-up occupying the same position in Listed company. So impressive on his Southwell debut before that, Charlie Appleby's colt remains a very nice prospect. Turty Tree was one of those left trailing in Water To Wine's wake at Newbury, but is dangerous in receipt of weight from the previous winners. Koala Rose showed abundant promise on her debut at Wolverhampton last year and requires more than a cursory glance.
