Tim Easterby's charge holds obvious claims from a 2lb lower mark and a fifth career victory may beckon. The lightly-raced Goyard merits respect at this level and market support ahead of his return to action must be noted. Multiple C&D winner Ventura Express arrives here in better form than most and is a feasible alternative.
