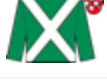
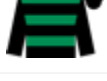

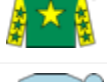

That shouldn't be an issue for BEST LOVE, being by Kodi Bear, and she produced a battling display to make the breakthrough at Navan. This extra furlong will suit and further success could be on the cards. The blinkered Howlin Wolf heads the remainder.

Having won twice last season when trained by Ger Lyons, she rounded out her campaign with a tilt at Listed honours. The daughter of Starspangledbanner then moved to Derek McCormack and went desperately close on her return to action at Navan. Improvement looks likely and she can go one place better. Motta Alta is also noted.

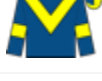

ATR VERDICT: SUMMER IS TOMORROW recorded a third career win when readily landing the odds at Gowran before a cracking fourth when prominent throughout in a valuable 1m2f Curragh handicap. The Joseph O'Brien-trained colt had Manton Bay, who didn't enjoy the clearest of passages but reopposes on 5lb worse terms, a length and a half behind in fifth. Action would be difficult to beat if reproducing his second to Item in the Dante at York back in the spring, but has been acting as a pacemaker when soundly beaten since. Caught U Sleeping, Latin America and Shaihaan are others to consider.

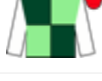

ATR VERDICT: Distillation could hardly have won any easier over C&D and is evidently heading in the right direction, but he's effectively 12lb higher under the 6lb penalty and DARK MANDATE is preferred as a result. ATR VERDICT: None of these have pulled up any trees so far but perhaps it is worth taking a chance on NIGHTBLOOM. Amo Racing parted with 400,000 euros to acquire the filly at the Goffs sales in September last year, but she was a disappointing favourite on her debut. There were more encouraging signs at Sandown and switching to the all-weather shouldn't be a problem, so it would come as no surprise were she to show her true colours on the back of wind surgery. Urumita shares a similar profile and is noted along with newcomer Oxbridge.

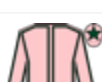
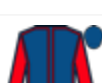
